


Power sources

Using a household AC outlet

FOR UNITED KINGDOM ONLY READ THE CAUTION FOR THE AC MAINS LEAD ON PAGE 7 BEFORE CONNECTION.

Connect the AC mains lead firmly to the unit and the outlet.



- The function selector switch does not separate entire unit from mains even if in "TAPE/OFF" position.

Using batteries (not included)

The unit cannot be powered by batteries if the AC mains lead is connected.




When to change the batteries

Sound quality and operations are affected when the batteries are running low. Replace all six batteries. It is also a good idea to replace all the batteries before recording.

Removing the batteries


Open the battery cover and insert your finger in the hole on the bottom of the unit and push out.



Memory back-up

During power supply interruption, memory backup batteries (not included) save CD programs and radio stations you have set.

These batteries do not power the unit.



When to change the batteries

The batteries last about a year.

Connect the unit to AC power before replacing the batteries.

Before connecting or disconnecting the AC mains lead, stop the tape and switch [SELECTOR] to "TAPE/OFF" to turn the unit off. The memory batteries are worn out faster if the cord is disconnected with the power still

Removing the batteries

Press the negative end of the number 4 battery and remove the batteries. (Remove the power batteries first.)

Operation notes

- Do not place obstacles between the remote control signal sensor and the remote control unit.





Normal tuning



Switch [SELECTOR] to "TUNER". (Unit comes on.)

2 Press [BAND] to select "FM" or "AM".

3 (Omit this step if using the remote control) If "PGM" is on the display, press [TUNE MODE] to clear it off.



△ Press [-/|**⋖⋖**] or [**▶▶**|/+] to tune to the desired station.



The frequency changes one step each time a button is pressed.

"ST" lights when an FM stereo broadcast is being received.

Automatic tuning

Keep [-/I◄◄] or [▶►I/+] depressed and release when the frequency display starts to change. A station with good reception is automatically selected and the process stops.

To stop automatic tuning, press [-/I◄◄] or [►►I/+] again.

Note

Automatic tuning may stop on a frequency where there is no station if there is interference. Press [–/l◄◀] and [▶►/+] to tune if this occurs.

5 Adjust the volume.

To use auto scan

You can search for a station by listening to all tuned-in stations for 8 seconds each.

Preparation: Switch [SELECTOR] to "TUNER".

- 1. Press [BAND] to select "FM" or "AM".
- 2. Press [AUTO SCAN].

Auto scan starts.



3. Press [AUTO SCAN] when you find the desired station.

Auto scan ends when it reaches the original frequency again. To stop during the process, press [AUTO SCAN].

To improve reception

FM: Extend the whip antenna and adjust its direction.


AM: Adjust facing of the unit.



Sound will be produced in monaural, but this also reduces noise. Press the button again to cancel. ("MONO" goes out.)

Preset tuning

Preset the stations (twelve FM and twelve AM) to make tuning simpler.



How to preset


Preparation: Tune to the desired station. (Do steps 1-4 on the left.)

1 Press [MEMORY].



While "PGM" and the frequency are flashing

Press [MEMORY].



Preset channel

While "PGM" and the preset channel are flashing

Press [-/l◀◀] or [▶▶l/+] to select the desired channel. (Remote control: [V] or [A])



4 Press [MEMORY]. (This completes presetting.)



Repeat the above to preset other stations.

Note

If "PGM" goes off during presetting, return to step 1.

To listen to preset channels

- Press [BAND] to select "FM" or "AM".
- (Omit this step if using the remote control) Press [TUNE MODE] to display "PGM".



3 Press [-/I◄◄] or [►►I/+] to select the desired channel (1-12). (Remote control: [V] or [∧])



To use preset scan

You can search for a station by listening to all preset channels for 8 seconds each.

Do steps 1 to 2 above.

For remote control, replace [-/I◄◄] or [▶►I/+] described below with [V] 2. Press and hold [-/I◄◄] or [▶►I/+] until "PS" appears on the display.

Indicates PS-5 preset scan

3. Press [-/I◄◄] or [▶►I/+] when you find the desired channel.

Preset scan ends after searching through each preset channel once. To stop during the process, press [-/I◄◄] or [►►I/+].
