Safety precautions

WARNING

Unit

- To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock or product damage,
 - Do not let water or other liquids drip or splash inside the unit.
 - Do not expose accessories (battery pack, battery charger, AC adaptor, SD memory card etc.) to rain, moisture, dripping or splashing.
 - Do not place objects filled with liquids, such as vases, on accessories.

AC adaptor

- To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock or product damage,

Placement

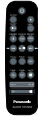
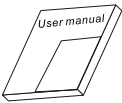
